

Psalms 36:7 “And the sons of men find shelter in the shadow of your wings.” Psalms 57:1 “In the shadow of your wings I will take refuge.” Psalms 61:4 “I will find refuge under the shelter of your wings.”

See Isaiah 31:5 “like birds hovering overhead, so the Lord of hosts will protect Jerusalem.” Isaiah 66:10-13. Comforting mother: “as a mother comforts her child, so will I comfort you.” Luke 15:8 “Or what woman, having ten silver coins, if she loses one coin, does not light a lamp, sweep the house, and search carefully until she finds it?”

Luke 13:34 (Matthew 23:37) “how often I desired to gather your children together as a hen gathers her brood under her wings.”

6. OTHER IMAGES.

Ruah – Genesis 2:7, Psalms 104:29; John 3:8 Presence that gives life; feminine Hebrew word meaning breath, wind, inspiration or spirit. Rahamin - Hebrew word for compassion – root word, -rahan, means womb.

Seamstress – Genesis 3:21. Washerwoman Isaiah 4:4, Psalm 51:7. Midwife –Psalms 22:9-11, Psalms 71:6; Isaiah 66:9 (This is speaking of Father and Mother). Woman baking bread (Matthew 13:33). Seeks justice (Proverbs 8:18). The True Vine (John 15:1; Psalms 128:3). The Cornerstone (Zechariah 10:4).

The Helpmate (Genesis 2:18). The Dove (Songs 2:14). Love (Songs 8:7). The Female Lamb (Leviticus 4:32, Revelation 22:1-3). The New Jerusalem (Revelation 21:2). The virtuous Woman (Proverbs 12:4). The Mother of us all (Galatians 4:26). The Wife of your youth (Proverbs 5:15 -19).

Other Titles: The Way of Holiness, the Eternity, the Slain Lamb, the Word, the little white stone, the Ark, the Beloved, the Blessed Woman, the source of the water of life, the Grace, the Water that cleans, the Final Trumpet, the Eternal Life, the Woman, the Moon, the Lioness, the Firstborn, the only Begotten One of God, The Angel of the little scroll, the Angel of the Covenant, the Wife of God, the Law, the Light.

You shall also be a crown of glory in the hand of the Lord, and a royal diadem in the hand of your God. You shall no longer be termed Forsaken, nor shall your land any more be termed Desolate; but you shall be called My Chosen one (My Delight is in Her), and your Land, My Wife. For the Lord delights in You, and He will be like a Husband for your Land. For as a young man marries his bride, so God will take you as His Wife. Will rebuild you and be happy with you, as the husband is happy with his wife (Isaiah 62:3-5).

“Honor your (Spiritual) Father and your (Spiritual) Mother, this is the first commandment with promise that it may go well for you, and your days may be lengthened.” Ephesians 6:2-3.

BIBLICAL PROOFS OF THE FEMININE FACE OF GOD IN THE SCRIPTURES

Introduction: Today Christ Lisbet, the Wife of God the Father Melquisedec has come down from the heaven of God (His mind) and has come to our minds to teach us what had been hidden for centuries and ages: God has a Wife! And She is Christ, and has always been a WOMAN. Let's take a look at this clear proof of the existence of God the Mother.

1. GOD AS THE “SOPHIA”, OR “WISDOM”.

The first nine chapters of Proverbs describe Wisdom as **feminine**. Evidence: **Proverbs 4:13** She is your life, and the Giver of life: “*Hold on to this instruction, do not let go of it; keep her, for She is your life.*” In **Proverbs 8:35**, says “*he who finds me finds the life.*”

Proverbs 8:15, She established righteousness, “*Thank Me kings reign and rulers establish the right.*” **Proverbs 8:22-31**: As the existing same Wisdom before the foundation of the world. As it says in **Proverbs 8:30**: “*Then I was beside Him organizing everything; and I was daily His delight, rejoicing always before Him.*”

Wisdom 7:22 and 8:1: She is the fashioner of all things; 21 attributes which is the product of two perfect numbers **3 and 7**. Wisdom is perfection multiplied by perfection: Intelligent, holy, unique, manifold, subtle, mobile. She is transparent, unpolluted, distinct, invulnerable, loving good, keen, and invincible.

She is also kind, the friend of man, firm, sure, has no worries, all-powerful. Wisdom oversees everything, penetrating through all the intelligent spirits.

Wisdom 8:1 She orders all things. Wisdom 7:24 She pervades and penetrates all things. Wisdom 7:27 She renews all things, is a renewable energy. Wisdom 9:10 She shares the throne of God. Wisdom 7:10-14 She is the source of all new things.

Sirach 1:1-8 It is God who knows Wisdom and pours Her forth upon the world.

Sirach 24:1-27 is a Hymn of self-praise sung by Wisdom, in which She describes Herself, Her origins, Her relationship to God and the good things She does for humans. She came from the mouth of God, She is God's Word, breath, Spirit; as the spirit/wind that hovered over the waters of creation and as mist/steam that covered the earth at the beginning. She is universal, is everywhere. Her image as a tree echoes Proverbs 8 "She strikes root among God's people. She feeds all who long for her. Her food is sweeter than honey. Her food is Herself. All who eat of Her will hunger still; who drink of Her will thirst for more. One will never be able to get enough of what She offers. What She offers is life." She concludes Her song with a promise similar to **Proverbs 8:34-35** "Those who obey Her will not be shamed. Those who serve Her will not fall short." She is the personified Wisdom of God, as the FEMININE archetype.

2. THE GOD WHO GIVES BIRTH, THE WOMB.

Evidence: **Deuteronomy 32:18**: "You forget the ROCK who begot you, unmindful of the God who gave birth to you." Let's look at Job 38:28 and 29: "God's fathering of rain and giving birth to ice from her womb."

Isaiah 42:14: "I have kept silent for a long time; yes, I have restrained myself. But now, like a woman in labor, I will cry and groan and pant." Isaiah 46:3 and 4: "You who have been carried since birth, whom I have carried since time you were born." Incubated in God's Womb.

John 1:12: "Those who believe in God are born of God." 1 John 4:7: "Everyone who loves is born of God." See also John 16:21: God is bringing forth a new humanity like the pangs of a woman in labor; her hour has come. Acts 17: In God we live and move and have our being.

Galatians 4:19: God's womb is in pain, "Oh, my dear children! I feel as if I'm going through labor pains for you again, and they will continue until Christ is fully developed in your lives." See also Romans 8:22: "From the beginning to now the entire creation has been groaning in one great act of giving birth (creation). So far we know that the whole creation groans and suffers like a woman in travail." "We know that everything on the earth cries out with pain, as a woman giving birth to a child."

3. GOD, CREATOR OF ISRAEL.

Is also imaged as the shaper, maker and Mother God who formed Israel in the womb and birthed Israel with labor pains (Deuteronomy 32:18; Psalms 90:2; Proverbs 8:24-25; Isaiah 43:1, 7, 15; 44:2, 24; 45:9, 11; 51:13; 54:5).

From the word "womb" (rehem) comes the verb "to have compassion" (raham), and the phrase "Yahweh's compassionate (raham) and gracious" repeatedly appears in the Hebrew scripture to describe the merciful and saving acts of God in history. (Deuteronomy 4:31; 2 Chronicles 30:9; Nehemiah 9:17; Psalms 78:38; 86:16; 103:8; 111:4; 112:4; 145:8; John 4:7).

These verses show the representation of God as showing compassion (Rahum), giving birth of a "womb" or bosom (Rehem) his son Israel. The God Creator is sometimes represented as a woman giving birth and sometimes as an image of God as spawning, both male and female.

4. THE NURSING MOTHER.

Evidence: Isaiah 49:15 "Does a woman forget her baby at the breast, or fail to cherish the son (daughter) of her womb?" Numbers 11:12: "Did I conceive all these people, was it I who gave them birth that you should say to me, "carry them in your bosom, like a mother carries a nursing baby?"

Psalms 131:2-3 But I have calmed and quieted my soul, like a weaned child with its mother; my soul within me is like a weaned child. See also 1 Peter 2:2 and 3: "You are newborn and like babies you should be hungry for nothing but milk – now that you have tasted the goodness of Christ."

5. NURTURING GOD: MOTHER.

Evidence: Genesis 1:2 nesting MOTHER. Deuteronomy 32:11 and 12, the mother eagle. Hosea 11:3: "I myself taught Ephraim to walk, I took them in my arms." Hosea 13:8: "I will fall upon them like a bear robbed of her cubs." Read Psalms 131:2, Image of repose: "Surely I have calmed and quieted my soul, like a weaned child with his mother."

Psalms 17:8: "Guard me in the shadow of your wings."
