

"THE CROSS OF CALVARY" SACRIFICE OR ATROCIOUS CRIME?

Dear reader, it is our desire that through the following information you will be enlightened about an idea that has been promoted and believed for centuries and ages, as well as a mistake that Christian faith has clung to. We are referring to the death of Christ, which took place more than twenty centuries ago and that has been mistakenly considered a sacrifice for the salvation of mankind. In this brochure we will broaden the content of the previous material: "EVIDENCE OF A TRUTH ABOUT THE CHRIST THAT THEY WANTED TO HIDE".

Before we begin, we must make some clarifications.

The first one leads us to understand the concepts of **salvation** and **eternal life**. These two terms relate to the immortality of the body, which according to the traditional theological information is granted through the so-called sacrifice of Christ on the cross two thousand years ago. But we invite you to ask yourselves the following question; do you know anyone who believed in the Christ of the first century, who has obtained physical immortality? You don't right? So then, based on that single verifiable fact, we must start thinking that

something is not right about the information that has been presented regarding to what happened on Mount Calvary.

For this reason, our interest and purpose for this material, is first, to bring you to consider and review the information that you have received so far and finally, to deliver you the truth about the facts that are stated here.

Next, we will show you convincing biblical evidence that will allow you to have a greater comprehension of the facts, just as they happened.

John 17:3 says:

*"Now this is eternal life:
that they know you, the only
true God,
and Jesus Christ, whom you
have sent."*

It's important to know God the Father through the Christ he's sent in these end times in order to receive eternal life.

Do you know anyone who has believed in the death of the Christ from the first century that has received physical immortality?

1 Corinthians 2:7-8

⁷ But we speak God's secret wisdom that has been hidden from everyone until now. God planned this wisdom for our glory. He planned it before the world began.

⁸ None of the rulers of this world understood this wisdom. If they had understood it, they would not have killed our great and glorious Lord on a cross.

There is an expression used in this portion of the Bible that says: "**secret wisdom**". The lack of knowledge about this secret wisdom is what led to the death of Christ, which is why it also says: "**If they had understood it, they would not have killed our great and glorious Lord on a cross**". Based on this postulate presented by Paul, we can arrive to the following conclusion:

That two types of authors participated in the death of Christ, the intellectual ones and the material ones. The intellectual authors were composed of the religious leaders of that time and the people who were influenced by them. On the other hand, the material authors were the Romans led by Pontius Pilate.

It is essential to be clear about these two groups in this scenario, as the intellectual authors were never able to understand the secret wisdom and that is why they pressured the Romans to execute her.

We would also like to clarify, to the reader a very important detail: **the cross as an element of death has no prophetic significance**. The fact that Christ had been hung on a cross was

only a circumstantial event, due to the cross being an element used by the Romans to execute those sentenced to death in that time. Before observing the conversation between Pilate and Christ, we must consider the following details and ask ourselves.

Why was Christ brought before Pilate?

The reason is simple, the people of Israel were under the Roman domain and that is why the Jews could not execute anyone, because that was a right reserved for the Romans. We do not want you to lose sight of the motivation the Jewish leaders had to cause the people to go against the Christ, which we saw in the very first verse, was based on the fact that they did not understand the secret wisdom. However, those evil and perverse men used another argument before Pilate to be able to accuse Christ. They accused her of sedition or rebellion. They made her look like a revolutionary who was ruffling the people against the Roman Empire. For this reason, when Pilate questioned her, he wanted to know if Christ really represented a threat to the Roman Empire; when he understood that the matters which Christ dealt with were spiritual, he could not impute her, with any fault.

Acts 3:13

¹³ The God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, the God of our fathers, glorified His Servant Jesus, whom you delivered up and denied in the presence of Pilate, when he was determined to let Him go.

John 18:37

³⁷ Pilate therefore said to Him, "Are You a king then?" Jesus answered, "You say rightly that I am a king. For this cause I was born, and for this cause I have come into the world, that I should bear witness to the truth. Everyone who is of the truth hears My voice."

We understand from reading the verse, that it is never mentioned that Christ came to die in a physical way as it happened on the cross, but to bear witness to the truth.

Mark 1:38

³⁸ Jesus answered, "We should go to another place. We can go to other towns around here, and I can tell God's message to those people too. That is why I came."

In the text above, it can be inferred that her mission was not to die on a cross; her mission was to preach. Now ask yourselves, what did Christ preach in the first century? Her message was based on parables, which at that time were not understood since Christ said that it was not given to them to know these mysteries, that would be used as a platform to understand whom Christ would be, and as she would explain it in her manifestation today, during the end of time.

CHRIST OR BARABBAS

Every year during the Passover celebration, the governor would release a prisoner to the crowd. Pilate gave them to choose between Jesus and Barabbas, a murderer. The priests and elders persuaded the people to choose Barabbas, and the governor said to them: "What crime has Jesus committed?" but they shouted back: "Crucify him!". Seeing that the people became rowdier, Pilate released Barabbas and apprehended Jesus saying: "I am innocent of the blood of this just Person." (Matthew 27: 15-26)

Matthew 26:29

²⁹ But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom.

This verse shows us that the mission of Christ, was not met at the time. The preposition "**until**" and the demonstrative pronoun "**that**" indicate that it is not talking about something that happened but something that would happen in the future, when the Father's kingdom was established and in her function as the Christ, she could make it known in its entirety. Christ would establish an eternal and indestructible kingdom that would bring peace, justice and eternal life to all who believe in Her manifestation. This could not have been carried out two thousand years ago. The influence of men who ruthlessly went against her teachings and did not accept her mercy, can be seen in the cruel manner in which they crucified her without compassion. Not being able to fulfill her function, as saviour and redeemer of that generation, and not being accepted, what the prophets had written, also could not be fulfilled, and they all perished. Thus, that physical death of Christ was not the result of a redemptive sacrifice that helped humanity to attain eternal life, as this is only achieved by believing in Christ when she is present, preaching a message and in that way be saved by her faith. Therefore, what happened on the cross of Calvary was a crime caused by the disbelief and lack of understanding of men who could not bear her word.

Mark 14:35

³⁵ Jesus went on a little farther away from them, fell to the ground, and prayed. He asked that, if possible, he would not have this time of suffering.

After presenting this biblical portion, we invite you to take into deep consideration the following question: **If Christ came to die on the cross, why does she ask the Father if it was possible to be exempt**

from that situation? Because dying on the cross was not the plan; that death would not contribute to salvation or give eternal life to mankind. Just by observing that during the last twenty centuries no believer has obtained immortality, we realize that the crime committed at Calvary did not contribute anything.

The expressions used by Christ on the cross could be interpreted as an apparent abandonment by the Father, but they are of a person who is anguished by experiencing such unnecessary suffering.

Matthew 27:46

⁴⁶ And about the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eli, Eli, lama sabachthani?" that is, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?"

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Based on the evidence provided, we would like to awaken your understanding so that you may realize the deceit in which humanity has been immersed. What happened on that wooden cross over twenty centuries ago was a heinous crime, which was not prophesied and did not provide any benefit to mankind.

The sacrifice that fulfills its purpose of giving eternal life to all men is the one being done today by Christ Lisbet, who out of love for us made herself poor; in other words, she dressed in a body of death, to enrich us with eternal life. That is why she has taken human form

to show us the name of the Father Melquisedec, acquire a new name and preach to give her Spirit to those who hear and receive her, today.

This is why it is very important to receive and not reject her, as it happened two thousand years ago, as it would be as rejecting life itself. God does not want anyone's death and Christ's purpose today is to revive the mortal body and give it a spirit that will never die and live forever in health, perfection, justice and peace that please God so that he may be glorified in us.
